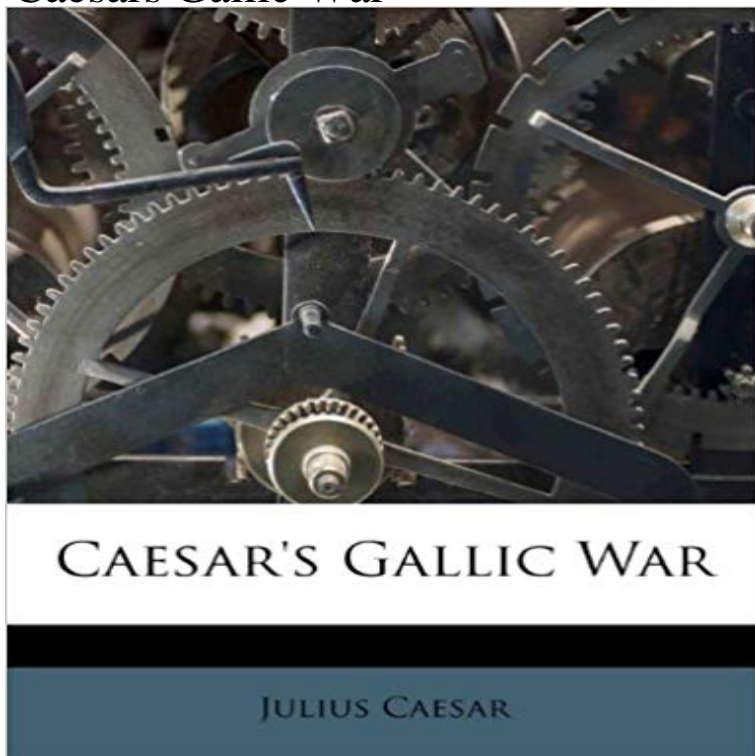


Caesars Gallic War
